

Determining LMI for HUD Community Development Projects

- Open Map by clicking on “View” – top right of page
- 1. Search for address in top right search field
- 2. Pick Layer– see icons at top left of page. Layer is the icon that looks like a stack of paper. Select “LMISD by Block Group” and uncheck the other options
- 3. Choose a Basemap Option by clicking the icon that looks like four little squares under the Layer icon. Select “Charted Territory Map”
- 4. Select a Service Area by clicking the icon under the Basemap Option with the little arrow. LMISD Block Group should be selected already. Click on the little down arrow in the large green Select button and choose “select by lasso” – **DO NOT CLOSE POP UP**
- 5. Pick a point on the map and draw your lasso – the map may widen your lasso to include additional areas if your lasso represents a data set that is too small
- 6. In the “Select Service Area” popup, click on three dots to the right of “LMISD by Block Group” and Export to CSV file

To determine LMI percent for selected area:

1. Add the values in column L (Lowmod)
2. Add the values in column N (Lowmoduniv)
3. Divide the sum of L by the sum of N
4. Multiply the result by 100

- To qualify for the LMI National Objective, the total must be 51% or greater

=SUM(L2:L3)/SUM(N2:N3)*100
